#### Parent Consultations

Thank you to everyone that took the time to receive a phone call from your child's teacher to discuss their progress. I appreciate that some parents were disappointed that we could not hold the Parent Conference face to face.



As I discussed in my earlier correspondence, our rates have been escalating for a few weeks amongst staff and children. Therefore, we took advice from Public Health and cancelled all assembly gatherings, encouraged parents to LFT their children and kept visitors into school to an absolute minimum. These precautions will be in place until after Easter to minimise the risks, break transmission and prevent us from sending home classes to complete their learning on line or worse, that we have to close the school; I am sure you can appreciate that this would affect many families and in particular the children.

It is our intention to invite parents into school in the summer term so you are able to look at the work completed by your child together and share in their learning.

#### Year 6—RoadSense Workshop


