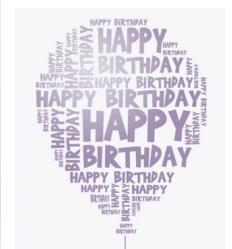
Congratulations to Jacob in Year 2 who has been scouted to play for Blackpool FC pre academy. Talent galore in St Bernadette's - well done, Jacob !
