Science Workshop

St, Bernadette's are lucky enough to have a strong relationship with the Ogden Trust, a science education organisation. On Wednesday, 52 pupils from across Key Stage Two had the opportunity to attend a science workshop, led by Lancaster University. The event was hosted by Montgomery High School.

Spending time in a real planetarium enabled pupils to experience the first moon landing, the solar system, the constellation of the stars and how a trip to Mars might look! The special effects were spectacular.

Children were then shown into the science laboratories and had hands-on experience with a number of practical experiments such as: liquid nitrogen, levitation, the Van de Graaf generator, how to create an orbiting solar system with marbles and physics and much more! Our budding scientists were a credit to St Bernadette's!
