To ensure a 10am arrival, children will need to be in school by 8:20am on the day of the trip. This will allow sufficient time for toileting and registration before departure. A text will be sent nearer the time to remind you.

Essential information for the visits:

- Children will need to bring a packed lunch and water bottle to school.
 Should you wish for a school-provided packed lunch, please indicate this on the Google Form.
 - o Please refrain from sending chocolate bars and fizzy drinks.
- As this is an outdoor experience, children should anticipate getting muddy and wet despite the summer season. Therefore, children should wear appropriate clothing for the day and bring water-proofs and wellies in a separate bag.
 - Light clothing is advised due to the time of year (e.g. joggers / leggings and t-shirt would be fine underneath waterproof clothing).
 - o A sunhat is advisable.
 - Sun cream should be applied before coming to school.
 - o Children will need a bag to put any dirty clothing/waterproofs into.
 - Should you require wellies or waterproofs, please let Mr.
 Hopkinson or the office know in advance of the visit to allow time to obtain them.
 - You may wish to include a change of socks should your child get wet feet.

I have taken children to Brockholes before and it has always been a fun and eventful day. The staff at Brockholes have proven to be knowledgeable and amazing with the children, nurturing and promoting a love of the outdoors.
